- Should you arrive later, you will need to be escorted from the gate to your lodge. There is a strict policy that the gates will be impassable after 21h00.

## DINING

Operating times are as follows:

 Breakfast is served in the dining room 09:30 -10:30, however we do cater for early departures upon request

## PLEASE NOTE

- Pets are not allowed within the reserve
- Smoking will only be permitted in designated areas
- Park entrance fee: R180 per adult and R65 per child (children aged 11 and under) per night
- Tourism levy: R10 per person per night
- Conservation levy: R190 per adult per night and R95 per night, per child aged 2-11
- Landing fee: R240 per person per stay for the Eastern and Western airstrip and R150 per child (subject to reserve changes)
- Transfer fee: R110 per person from the Western airstrip
- Special dietary requirements, no problem, please be so kind as to send them through prior to arrival. (Surcharges may apply)
- All beverages and extras consumed on site are charged on consumption

## CHILDREN'S POLICY

- Children under the age of 6 are not permitted on safari activities. Where possible, family game drives will be arranged.
- Babysitting services can be arranged at the lodge at an additional charge.
- Children 0-5 years of age stay free of charge only when sharing with 2 full-paying adults.
- Children 6-11 years of age pay 50% of the adult sharing rate when sharing with 2 full-paying adults.
- Children 12 years and older occupying their own room pay full adult rates.
- The adult rate applies when a child over 12 years old shares with 1 adult.

## ACCOMMODATION

Includes breakfast, lunch, dinner, 2 game drives per day with snacks (morning and late afternoon), soft drinks, local wines, beer & local pouring brands and spirits.

- Main bedroom with a double bed or 2 single beds

## **Deluxe River Family Chalets**

- Main bedroom with a double bed or 2 single beds

- Main bedroom with a double bed only
- En-suite bathroom with a bath only
- Outdoor shower

#### LOAD SHEDDING & POWER INFORMATION

- The resort is equipped with a backup generator in case of load shedding or Eskom technical difficulties.
- In the unlikely event of a technical failure with the generator, please be aware that the resort does not have any battery-operated lighting available. We will endeavour to work as fast as possible to resolve the issue.
- Certain services and facilities may not be available during load shedding times. Please contact the resort to familiarise yourself with these interruptions.
- The resort may be restricted to operating times and/or duration of the backup generator due to legislation/regulations in certain areas, as well as generator capacity. Please contact the resort for further information.
- Due to the high running cost of generators, a daily generator fuel levy may be applied at the resort to ensure uninterrupted power to your room. Please contact the resort for further information.

## DIRECTIONS From Johannesburg via the N4 Via Abjaterskop Gate Route

- From O.R. Tambo International Airport get on the R21 towards Pretoria
- Take exit to N1 Polokwane (about 37km)
- Continue up to N4 Rustenburg slipway (22km). This is just after the Zambezi drive offramp.
- Continue on N4 through Swartruggens towards Zeerust
- In Zeerust, turn right at the ABSA bank in Main Street, towards Gaborone/Madikwe (refuel here)
- After approximately 83km you will see the Abjaterskop Entrance into the reserve on the right
- Continue 32km on dirt road
- Once through the gate, continue straight for 10.8km (the road is tarred after a few km)
- Turn left at T-junction (Derdepoort)
- After 2km turn right at the sign saying Park Admin (if the road becomes gravel, you've gone too far)

• Drive for 1km, past the entrance to Park Admin and turn left at sign saying Derdepoort

## From Johannesburg via the N4 Via Molatedi Gate Route (route not recommended)

- From O.R. Tambo International Airport get on the R21 towards Pretoria
- Take exit to N1 Polokwane (about 37km)
- Continue up to N4 Rustenburg slipway (22km). This is just after the Zambezi drive offramp.
- Take exit 225 (R556 Sun City/Majakaneng) about 64km
- Turn right at the offramp
- Continue straight to Sun City (approximately 73km)
- After passing Sun City on the right, continue straight (approximately 5km)
- At the 4-way junction, turn right to Mabeeskraal
- Continue for 39.8km until the 4-way stop at the end of Mabeeskraal
- Turn right and continue on the road until you pass Dwarsberg Liquor store on the left
- Continue straight for about 7km your will pass
  Obakeng village
- Continue on the road until you see where the road is closed and turn left to Molatedi village
- Continue until you pass Molatedi village, you will reach the gravel road that takes you to Molatedi Game approximately 10km
- On the way to Molatedi village there will be a turn off on the right to Derdepoort. This is a gravel road and we do not recommend it. This road is very bad especially when driving a small car
