- Please note our Ferry boat has been taken out the water due to damage. We still offer the service but will be very much based on weather conditions. All other boating activities are still available.

LOAD SHEDDING & POWER INFORMATION

- The resort is equipped with a backup generator in case of load shedding or Eskom technical difficulties.
- In the unlikely event of a technical failure with the generator, please be aware that the resort does not have any battery-operated lighting available. We will endeavour to work as fast as possible to resolve the issue.

- Certain services and facilities may not be available during load shedding times. Please contact the resort to familiarise yourself with these interruptions.
- The resort may be restricted to operating times and/or duration of the backup generator due to legislation/regulations in certain areas, as well as generator capacity. Please contact the resort for further information.
- Due to the high running cost of generators, a daily generator fuel levy may be applied at the resort to ensure uninterrupted power to your room. Please contact the resort for further information.

DIRECTIONS FOR SELF DRIVE From Johannesburg

- Follow the route through Bethal, Ermelo, Piet Retief and then through Pongola, taking the N2 southbound to Hluhluwe
- Take the Hluhluwe offramp

From Durban

- Follow the N2 northbound to Hluhluwe.
- Take the Hluhluwe offramp

From Hluhluwe

- Please note that the Engen garage is the last petrol station, so we advise you to fill up your car
- Travel through Hluhluwe, at the fourth traffic circle turn left, then travel 1.5km and turn right on the R22 Sodwana Road, crossing over the railway. From the railway tracks travel straight for 25.4km.
- There will be a brown road sign saying Nibela Lake Lodge, turn in 500m. Follow the green Nibela and Sobhengu signs.
- Turn right onto the dirt road at the L554 road sign. Travel straight for 4.2km, where you will reach a crossing, turn right at the L542 at the crossing. Travel straight for 4.6km to a Tjunction. Turn right at the T-junction at the sign L541, travel straight for 13km.
- Please note that you are now travelling through a tribal area, please be aware of livestock on the road and schools in the area. Animals are unpredictable. Please slow down when passing people and animals on the road. It is advisable to only travel at 60km/h.
- At the gate, make use of the intercom or call the lodge on 035 562 9005 /071 100 8886. Gates will be locked from 22:00 to 05:00 daily. Once inside the property, please follow the signs to reception for check-in at Nibela and receive your keys and instructions to your unit.











DIRECTIONS TO THE FERRY TRANSFER Once in Hluhluwe

- Travel through Hluhluwe, at the fourth traffic circle turn left, then travel 1.5km and turn right on the R22 Sodwana Road, crossing over the railway. From the railway tracks travel straight for 7km.
- There will be a brown road sign saying False Bay Resorts turn right here onto the P414.
- After 3.7km turn left onto the D540- following the signs for False Bay Resorts.
- Turn Right into False Bay and report to gate.
- Through the gate follow the signs to the main office for False Bay.
- · Day Visitors to park at the Main office
- Overnight guests to meet representative of the lodge to unpack onto the ferry and be directed to parking.
- Please ensure you close your windows and lock your doors.
- Remove everything from the vehicle that you may need for your holiday.
- The ferry trip is 40 min long, the boat has cooldrinks and water available please note that any drinks consumed will be charged to your account on arrival.
- Please phone +27 (0)71 100 8886 should you get lost along the way.
- Please phone if you do not think you will make the scheduled pick-up time. The ferry may not be able to wait, and a private transfer will need to be arranged at an additional cost.
- Please have cash available for False Bay Entry Fee's. Rates are available on below link https://isimangaliso.com/useful-information/park-entry-fees/
- Please phone +27 (0)71 100 8886 should you get lost along the way or for arrivals after 21:30.
- We recommend you check your route on google maps before leaving home.
- The dirt road travel is now 26kms
- Once on road A1115 keep driving south- we are situated right at the end of road A1115.
